

PUBLIC NOTICE:

Recognition Status of Programmes Offered at Post-Secondary and Tertiary Institutions

The Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (ACTT) wishes to advise the public that institutions must be registered, accredited or recognised and their programmes approved or accredited by ACTT *prior to* them advertising or enrolling students in any programme at the post-secondary or tertiary level. ACTT will not recognise programmes offered by any institution that has not obtained the required status.

Institutions and programmes that are recognised are listed on ACTT's Compendium (actt.org.tt/services/registration/compendium-of-institutions). In keeping with the General Conditions agreements signed by institutions that have been quality assured by ACTT, institutions are also reminded that the period of registration, accreditation or recognition is clearly identified therein and the Conditions are not retroactive.
