Dr Eduardo Ali is the Executive Director of the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago. Dr Ali's career, which has influenced over 20 Caribbean countries, the Middle East, the United States and Canada, has principally focused on post-secondary and higher education sector development and quality assurance and accreditation for two decades Between 2003-2007, he has worked with the Government of Trinidad and Tobago as Director-Distance Learning and Head of Higher Education Services and was responsible for leading Caribbean policy, strategic planning and international cooperation initiatives for transformation of early childhood, vocational and tertiary education at the CARICOM Secretariat. He also led institutional effectiveness, quality assurance and accreditation at the Council of Legal Education, two campuses of the University of the West Indies and two universities in the United Arab Emirates. Dr Ali has been actively engaged in consultancies with the European Union, Inter-American Development Bank, World Bank, Commonwealth of Learning, UNESCO institutes and UN Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean in accreditation and open and distance learning.
